**Art: Cave Painting**

The children will have fun learning about Art in the Stone Age; hand painting, painting upside down and developing skills to produce an end piece of work that reflects their interpretation of real cave paintings that have been studied.

**Science:**

**Topic:** Rocks, Soils and Fossils

- Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties.
- Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock.
