As part of your child's summer research this year, we are asking your child to investigate and research information about the Stone Age. Our Geography, History, Art and some of our English topics will be themed around this. Therefore, it will give them a great advantage to have prior knowledge of some of the key facts and information. Your child's teacher has already spoken to them about the type of information that could be included, however, the more varied and unusual the information, the more exciting our work can be! If your child's teacher has provided you with a scrapbook or folder, then this can be decorated - make it their own! We would also like the children to come up with at least 3 questions about information that they would like to know. We will aim to research, and find out the answers during our lessons. The children will continue to use this information throughout the year, and just keep adding to it. Please make it as creative and informative as you can.

In addition to this, the children may wish to keep a diary to maintain the level of writing that they have reached. This will also help us to get to know your child better!

By the end of year 4, all children should have learnt all their times tables (up to and including the 12's). Please continue to practice these as you have been doing this year. Children already in KS2 will be able to access 'Times Tables Rock Stars', whilst children new to KS2 will be able to use 'Hit the Button' to practice. Little and often is the best policy with all learning!
